The Evolution of Western Society: from Plato to Freud	20	This module will provide a broad introduction to historical periods and major turning points in Western society.	500-word critical analysis (30%) 1500-word written assignment (70%)
Reading the Visual	20	This module analyses the way the form and media construct ways of seeing and representing the world	1000-word close reading (40%)  Exam (75 minutes + 15 minutes reading time) (60%)
