First find out which travel company provides the service in your area:

First Eastern Counties Bus

For students who live in an area where they can catch a First Counties Bus, the cheapest option is to buy your ticket straight from them, using their App.

You may find the termly solo tickets to be the best value as they give unlimited travel including evenings and weekends. To access these, you need to select the region "Norfolk and Suffolk" and then choose "Eastern Counties Communities." www.firstbus.co.uk/norfolk-suffolk/tickets/student-bus-travel/city-college-norwich

Konect Bus

If you live in an area served by Konect you can purchase good value student bus passes directly from them, giving you unlimited travel. For 2025-26 ticket options please contact them via their website or ring **03300 539 358**.

Norfolk County Council Travel passes

If you cannot get a First or Konect bus because they do not serve the area where you live it is worth considering whether a bus pass from Norfolk County Council might be more economical and affordable. These can only be used Monday to Friday, term time only.

To be eligible for this, you first need to see whether you live within the core area served by the council. You can see the maps for City College Norwich, Paston and Easton campuses on the Norfolk County Council website: www.norfolk.gov.uk/education-and-learning/school-and-college-transport

You have two main options for the NCC pass; you can either pay in advance for the bus pass or you can order a free bus pass and pay the bus driver each day on the bus.

1.Pay in advance option

You can order a bus pass and choose to pay annually, termly or half termly. These bus passes can only be used to travel to and from college, during term time. They cannot be used for other journeys. The annual cost is £630; this is reduced to £474 if you are on certain means tested benefits.

2. Pay daily option

On the online application you need to tick the box to say you would like to pay daily. A pass will be posted out to you, which you must show to the bus driver to get the reduced fare. The most you will pay is £3.60 for a return ticket. Those on means tested benefits may be able to get a reduced rate of £3.10. The passes are issued for the full academic year. However, at the end of each term you will be sent a renewal email or letter asking you to confirm if you wish to continue as a daily fare payer. If you do not respond to this email your bus pass will be cancelled.
